

LOOKING AFTER YOUR PUMPING STATION

Sewage pumps are designed to handle effluent containing solids, they are, however, prone to blocking if abused. The more solids that enter the pumping station the greater the risk.

Your pumps will handle sanitary products, condoms, toilet paper in reasonable amounts.

The pumps will struggle to cope with cleaning wipes, baby wipes and make-up removing wipes etc..

These products do not bio-degrade within the pump station and get caught in the pump impellor and shaft causing failure.

Call-outs to unblock pumps are chargeable but easily avoidable!!

You should not allow fat, oil or grease to enter the pumping station as this congeals and clings to the floatswitches preventing them to working correctly.

Fat also attacks rubber cables and can result in water ingress into the pump motors and floatswitches leading to failure.
